

# Conversion – from wicked to righteous

---

Psalms 19:7 The **law of the LORD** is perfect, **converting** the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, **making wise the simple**.

8 The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: **the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes**.

9 The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether.

10 More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb.

11 Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward.

12 Who can understand his errors? cleanse thou me from secret faults.

13 **Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright, and I shall be innocent from the great transgression.**

*Psalms 51:13 Then will I teach transgressors thy ways; and **sinner**s shall be **converted** unto thee.*

Job 22:22 Receive, I pray thee, the law from his mouth, and lay up his words in thine heart.

Psalms 37:31 The law of his God is in his heart; none of his steps shall slide. *{steps: or, goings}*

Psalms 40:8 I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy law is within my heart.  
*{within...: Heb. in the midst of my bowels}*

Psalms 119:34 Give me understanding, and I shall keep thy law; yea, I shall observe it with my whole heart.

Psalms 119:70 Their heart is as fat as grease; *but* I delight in thy law.

Proverbs 3:1 My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments:

Isaiah 51:7 Harken unto me, ye that know righteousness, the people in whose heart is my law; fear ye not the reproach of men, neither be ye afraid of their revilings.

Jeremiah 31:33 But this *shall be* the covenant that I will make with the **house of Israel**;  
After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my **law** in their inward parts, and  
**write it in their hearts**; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Hebrews 8:10 For this *is* the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after  
those days, saith the Lord; I will **put my laws into their mind, and write  
them in their hearts**: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a  
people:

Hebrews 10: 14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever **them that are  
sanctified**.

15 *Whereof* the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before,  
16 This *is* the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I  
**will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them**;  
17 And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.  
18 **Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin.**

Deuteronomy 10:16 **Circumcise** therefore the foreskin of your **heart**, and be no more  
stiffnecked.

Deuteronomy 30:6 And the LORD thy God will **circumcise** thine **heart**, and the **heart** of  
thy seed, to love the LORD thy God with all thine **heart**, and with all thy soul,  
that thou mayest live.

Jeremiah 4:4 **Circumcise** yourselves to the LORD, and take away the foreskins of your  
**heart**, ye men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem: lest my fury come forth  
like fire, and burn that none can quench *it*, because of the evil of your doings.

Romans 2:29 But **he is a Jew**, which is one inwardly; and **circumcision is that** of the  
**heart**, in the spirit, *and* not in the letter; whose praise *is* not of men, but of God.

Matthew 19:17 And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good  
but one, that is, God: but

**if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments.**

Revelation 22:14 Blessed are they that **do his commandments**, that they may **have  
right to the tree of life, and** may enter in through the gates into the city.

Revelation 22:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they **that keep the  
commandments of God, and** the **faith of Jesus**.

1 John 3:7 Little children, **let no man deceive** you: he that doeth righteousness is  
righteous, even as he is righteous.

8 **He that committeth sin is of the devil**; for the devil **sinneth** from the  
beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might **destroy  
the works** of the devil.

9 Whosoever **is born** of God **doth not commit sin**; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

Romans 7: 7 ¶ What shall we say then? *Is* the law sin? God forbid. Nay, I had not known sin, but by the law: for I had not known lust, except the law had said, Thou shalt not covet. *{lust: or, concupiscence}*

8 But **sin**, taking occasion by the commandment, wrought in me all manner of concupiscence. For without the law sin *was* dead.

9 For I was alive without the law once: but **when the commandment came**, sin revived, and I died.

10 And the commandment, which *was ordained* to life, I found *to be* unto death.

11 For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me, and by it slew *me*.

12 Wherefore the **law is holy**, and the commandment **holy**, and just, and good.

13 Was then that which is good made death unto me? God forbid. But sin, that it might appear sin, working death in me by that which is good; that **sin by the commandment might become exceeding sinful**.

14 ¶ For we know that the **law is spiritual**: but I am carnal, sold under sin.

Romans 8:7 Because **the carnal mind** is enmity against God: for it is not **subject** to the **law** of God, neither indeed can be.

Psalms 19:7 The **law of the LORD** is perfect, **converting** the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, **making wise the simple**.

8 The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: **the commandment of the LORD is pure**, enlightening the eyes.

Matthew 11:27 **All things are delivered unto me of my Father**: and no man knoweth the Son, but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and he to whomsoever the Son will reveal him.

28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.

29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.

30 **For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light**.
